Your Honor:

Pursuant to Paragraph 1(E) of Your Honor's Individual Practices, the undersigned write on behalf of all parties to request that the First Amended Scheduling Order, dated June 4, 2012 (Docket No. 50), be modified as set forth herein and in the attached [Proposed] Second Amended Scheduling Order. The parties have been engaged in discovery and have determined that they require significantly more time to complete fact discovery, which is currently scheduled to be completed by August 13, 2012.

Accordingly, the parties request that all dates in the First Amended Scheduling Order be extended by six (6) months as follows: (i) fact discovery currently scheduled to be completed by August 13, 2012, be completed by February 13, 2013; (ii) plaintiffs' class certification motion currently scheduled to be filed by August 20, 2012, be filed by February 20, 2013; (iii) defendant's opposition to plaintiffs' class certification motion currently scheduled to be filed by September 17, 2012, be filed by March 18, 2013; (iv) plaintiffs' reply in support of class certification currently scheduled to be filed by October 1, 2012, be filed by April 1, 2013; and (v) expert discovery currently scheduled to be completed by October 1, 2012, be completed by April 1, 2013. The parties further request that all other dates in the First Amended Scheduling Order remain as set forth therein.
