ORDER

CHIN, Circuit Judge

By letter dated September 10, 2012, the parties jointly request an extension of time to complete discovery and a stay of the proceedings in this case pending the interlocutory appeal of my May 31, 2012 Order granting class certification in the related case. See Authors Guild v. Google, Inc., No. 05 Civ. 8136, 2012 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 76080 (S.D.N.Y. May 31, 2012).

The request is denied for the reasons I denied the request for a stay in Authors Guild v. Google, Inc. (See Order, Authors Guild v. Google, Inc., No. 05 Civ. 8136 (S.D.N.Y. Aug. 28, 2012), ECF No. 1062). Moreover, I note that the parties previously requested an extension of six months, and I allowed an extension of only two months. (See Endorsed Letter, Am. Soc'y of

Media Photographers, Inc. v. Google, Inc., No. 10 Civ. 2977

(S.D.N.Y. June 29, 2012), ECF No. 52).

I will, however, extend all of the deadlines by thirty (30) days. Accordingly, the following deadlines shall apply:

- (a) Fact discovery shall be completed by November 12, 2012.
- (b) Plaintiffs' class certification motion shall be filed by November 19, 2012.
- (c) Defendant's opposition to plaintiffs' class certification motion shall be filed by December 17, 2012.
- (d) Plaintiffs' reply in support of class certification shall be filed by December 31, 2012.
- (e) Expert discovery shall be completed by December 31, 2012.
- (f) Any summary judgment motion shall be filed twenty-eight (28) days after the Court's ruling on plaintiffs' class certification motion.

(g) Any opposition to any summary judgment motion shall be filed twenty-eight (28) days after any summary judgment motion is filed.

(h) Any reply in support of any summary judgment motion shall be filed fourteen (14) days after any opposition is filed.

The Clerk of the Court shall accept the joint letter for filing and docketing.
